## **THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW**

### **Carson Center Shuttle**

Buses begin route from the AQS Bus Stop (next to the Convention Center) to the Carson Center, 100 Kentucky Avenue, 45 minutes prior to the start of each event. Buses return to the AQS Bus Stop at the conclusion of the event.

### **Dining at the Show**

Food vendors provide a variety of dining options and a tent with seating in the parking lot across from the Carroll Convention Center from 10 AM-5 PM. Coffee and limited breakfast items, local specialties and a buffet during the live auction. More dining options in the Atrium of the Carroll Convention Center and the concession stand in the hallway of the Paducah Expo Center.

### **Getting Around Town**

Free bus service provided by participating hotels, attractions, Paducah Visitors Bureau and Anchor Tours. Bus routes and authorized stops are published in the AQS Showbook. Free Downtown and LowerTown trolley rides provide access to the National Quilt Museum, AQS Vendors on Kentucky and the AQS Bus Stop.

Or, **"Park and Ride"**: park at Carson Park (28th St./Joe Clifton Drive) and ride the Express Shuttle Bus to and from the AQS Bus Stop and Carson Park.
